

## COOKIES

A cookie is a small text file which a page on Delphi's website may request to save on your computer. If you do not want cookies to be saved on your computer, you can prevent this by changing the settings on your web browser. If you choose not to accept cookies, you can still use the website but its functionality will be limited.

Delphi's website uses session cookies. These are temporary files which are stored on your computer during the time you visit the website but which are deleted when you close your web browser. Session cookies are used to keep track of which information searches relate to each visitor. The information is not stored nor is it shared with others.

Through Google Analytics, Delphi's website also uses persistent cookies. These cookies gather information on an aggregated level about how visitors use the website. This may include which pages are shown, the duration of a visit, and which keywords are used. The analysis tool is used to enable us to improve the website on an ongoing basis and to make it easier for visitors to find information. Information which is provided by the cookies is not shared with others and if you do not accept cookies, no information will be gathered..
