To be able to use the website Delphi.se in our intended way, you need to allow cookies to be stored on your computer. Cookies are used to give you as a visitor access to different functionalities and to optimize your use of our website. For further information about our processing of personal data through cookies, [please see our privacy policy](#).

What cookies are and how they are used

A cookie is a small text file that the website you are visiting asks you to save on your computer (similar devices with internet connection such as tablets and mobile phones are also included). For more general information about cookies, please see www.pts.se/cookies, www.aboutcookies.org and/or www.allaboutcookies.org/.

There are two types of cookies, persistent cookies and session cookies. Both types of cookies are used on Delphi's website. Session cookies are stored temporarily when you as a visitor visit and browse our website, and are deleted when you close your web browser. Persistent cookies are stored as a file on the computer during a period of time, until you as a visitor or the server who sent them, delete them.

Furthermore, cookies can be divided into first and third-party cookies. First-party cookies are set by the website owner (Delphi.se in this case) and third-party cookies are set by another website. Both first and third-party cookies are used on Delphi's website.

Delphi uses Google Analytics as a statistical analysis tool to get a picture of how our visitors use the website and to evaluate how the website can be developed, e.g. to improve the content, navigation and structure of the website.

delphi-accepted-gdpr	Cookie which is set when you click on the GDPR/Cookie banner on the website, so that you do not get disturbed by the message in the future.	30 days	No.

pll_language	Used to remember the language setting which was latest used by the visitor.	1 year	No.

If you choose to disable cookies, it may mean that certain functions on the website will not work and that your user experience is affected negatively.
